They bring a wealth of singing and teaching experience to their events, as well as a fund of good humour that makes learning a delight.

Hailed as “one of the best harmony groups in the country” by fRoots, and as “true tradition bearers” by Living Tradition, CMR's winning combination of glorious voices, breathtaking harmonies and warm stage presence creates “a mix made in heaven”.



In the past few years they've captivated audiences in the USA and Canada as well as the UK, turning their hands (and voices) with consummate ease to a wide range of mainly traditional material, strongly linked with each group member's regional identity.
